Summary of PPG spending

Objectives in spending PPG:

Permanent employment of 1 AAC Senior Teaching Assistant and 1 Moving & Handling /Physical Development Senior Teaching Assistant in order to enable

1. pupils to make or exceed expected progress in English and Maths and specifically developing attention skills, Hi Tech Augmentative and Alternative Communication skills
2. pupils to develop optimum physical ability and independence in movement to enable improved expressive writing and language skills and development of fine and gross motor skills

Summary of spending and actions taken:

1x AAC Senior Teaching Assistant – development of AAC Group teaching

1x Moving & Handling / Physical Development Senior Teaching Assistant – development of MOVE programme

Outcomes to date:

- Increased expressive language progress for children using eyegaze technology
- Increase in number of children able to access and develop writing skills through either improved grasp of writing implements or ability to use AAC such as Eye Gaze
- Improved outcomes of children making more than expected progress in physical development including walking and independent standing
- Improved outcomes for children making above expected progress in expressive and receptive language skills
- improved outcomes for children developing social, emotional and mental health skills including making secure and sustainable friendships

Further actions for 2016-2017:

- to enable increased number of children entitled to Pupil Premium to access the MOVE programme
- to further develop high tech access to literacy and numeracy skills
